On the occasion of the ORF initiative “Long Night of Museums,” the MAK as the initiator of the VIENNA BIENNALE 2015: IDEAS FOR CHANGE invites visitors to a multifaceted program centered around the Biennale contributions at the MAK. Highlights and kids’ tours, film presentations, and the VIENNA BIENNALE PARTY are intended to spark confrontation with the topics of city and the urban future with a view to inspiring positive change in society. In the do-it-yourself workshop *Bauwerk:Stadt*, the changemakers from *2051: Smart Life in the City* demonstrate upcycling methods of urban construction, while at the *DIY Lemonade Stand* (in cooperation with LemonAid), visitors are invited to create their own lemonade. With their prototype of the *Zero Waste Kitchen*, the team from 1 qm Stadt alludes to urban mobility, regionality, and sharing communities, and prepares ecologically inspired fast food with the fruits of the *MAKfeld* urban gardening project, among other things.
