## SHEILA HICKS: TOTAL SENSUAL SUBMERSION

A new virtual 3D tour, an online guided tour, and an audio tour afford a glimpse of the MAK exhibition SHEILA HICKS: Thread, Trees, River

As part of its digital offerings, the MAK invites you to set out at once on a virtual visit to *SHEILA HICKS: Thread, Trees, River*, the MAK's major exhibition that opened in December 2020. A new virtual 3D tour allows you to explore the sensuous, vibrantly colorful, subtle, and at the same time monumental, room-filling objects in the exhibition. An online guided tour with the exhibition's curator Bärbel Vischer, curator of the MAK Contemporary Art Collection, reveals the complexity of the first solo exhibition in Austria dedicated to this internationally renowned artist and virtuoso of the textile arts. Accompanying these visual tours is an audio tour recorded by actress Louise Prack—an acoustic journey through *Thread, Trees, River*.
