The MAK DAY 2017 offers free admission and a jam-packed program for the entire family on the Austrian National Day. This year, furniture secrets that are usually beyond visitors' reach take center stage in numerous guided tours of the MAK on Stubenring and the MAK Branch Geymüllerschlössel. The hidden mechanisms, functions, and histories of exceptional pieces of furniture from the MAK Collection—such as the Rosa Krenn cabinet and the Roentgen gaming table—will be revealed to visitors to the Stubenring site. Three special tours revolve around the current exhibition *THOMAS BAYRLE: If It's Too Long—Make It Longer*.

Other highlights of the MAK DAY 2017 include two guided tours of the Geymüllerschlössel with MAK Conservator Johannes Ranacher. Under the title *Furniture & Other Secrets: The Hefele Secretaire*, he will introduce visitors to the famous writing cabinet from 1840 that has more than 100 secret compartments. Among the other items on the program at the MAK Branch in Vienna's 18th district is a MINI MAK Tour for the whole family (children ages 4 and older).
