On the occasion of the exhibition *ICONIC AUBÖCK: A Workshop Shapes Austria's Concept of Design*, the podium discussion examines the world of design and opportunities for collectors of design objects. For such objects not only have a functional value; they also tell stories of creativity, innovation, cultural development, and networking.

The Carl Auböck workshop's iconic objects have been leaving their mark on Austrian design for over 100 years. The MAK is devoting a comprehensive exhibition to this legendary manufactory, focusing on works from the interwar and postwar years and the 1980s, and presenting an image of home interiors as testing grounds for Auböck designs.

The experts will discuss what makes a design object iconic, what influences have marked the Carl Auböck workshop over the generations, and what trends characterize the market for design objects.
